REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Registration must be submitted by mail, fax or online. Phone registration is not accepted. The member fee is \$60. The nonmember fee is \$120. The member fee is for current, active TMA members only. TMA membership is on an individual basis. If an individual registers for the member fee, but TMA has no membership record, the individual will be charged the nonmember fee unless s/he can produce proof of membership. Only those individuals who are registered attendees of the program may request a certificate of attendance.

Individuals who register online will receive an automated confirmation notice. Individuals who register by fax or mail will receive confirmation of registration by email within one week of receipt of their registration. *Please include an email address on your registration form. Once registration is processed, all individuals will receive an email with complete details about connecting to the webinar, both by phone and online to view the PowerPoint slides.*

All registered participants will receive a copy of the PowerPoint slides within five days prior to program.

CANCELLATION AND SUBSTITUTION POLICIES

Cancellations will not be reviewed or processed until they are received in writing (email is acceptable). Phone cancellations are not accepted. If your cancellation is received up to ten business days prior to the webinar, a refund will be issued less a \$15 processing fee. Cancellations received within ten business days of the program will not be refunded. TMA does not issue credits for future webinars. Please note that if you register for a webinar within ten days of the program, you will not be eligible for any type of refund should you need to cancel your registration. Cancellation policies apply to all registrants regardless of when the registration is submitted.

Substitutions are permitted at any time and will not be reviewed or processed until they are received in writing (email is acceptable). Phone substitutions are not accepted.
